



Surfing Lessons

Guest will leave from El Anclote Beach to one of our 22 Surfing Beaches in Punta de Mita area such as: Playa La Lancha, Roca Negra, Los Burros, etc. Beach will be selected according to sea conditions and guest abilities. These locations are 15 to 30 minutes away from our departure point.

A quick briefing about surfing lesson and important points about surfing will be given before starting. A surfer instructor will be with participants all the times...

Guest must confirm their skills based on the below:

Beginners: They have taken 10 lessons or less

Intermediated: They Surf on their own, can take waves but will not do any tricks

Advanced: They can Surf with all board types (short board, long board, high performance) they need instructors only for coaching.

Huichol Indigenous Art Workshop

Huichol art broadly groups the most traditional and most recent innovations in the folk art and handcrafts produced by the Huichol people, who live in the states of Jalisco, Durango, Zacatecas and Nayarit in Mexico. The unifying factor of the work is the colorful decoration using symbols and designs which date back centuries. The most common and commercially successful products are bead art. The Huichol have a long history of beading, making the beads from clay, shells, corals, seeds and more using them to make jewelry and to decorate bowls and other items. The "modern" beadwork usually consists of masks and wood sculptures covered in small, brightly colored commercial beads fastened with wax and resin. While the materials have changed a bit, the religious purpose involve have not change over the years.

The religious faith of the Huichols is still based on a "trinity" of veneration of the deer, corn, and peyote. The last is ritually gathered each year on a long pilgrimage to the desert area of San Luis Potosí, where the people are said to have originated and used by shamans. They did not have a written language until recently, so these symbols were and are the primary form of preserving the ceremonies, myths, and beliefs of ancient Huichol religion. Allow the Huichol master craftsman Rutukame Gonzalez lead us through the journey of his hands to teach us the most beautiful of magic and the color of Mexico.
